7 Section 4. Section 3117(r) and (s) of Title 75 are amended  
8 and the section is amended by adding a subsection to read:

9 § 3117. Automated red light enforcement systems in certain  
10 municipalities.

12 (r) Report.--The department shall conduct an evaluation of  
13 section 3116 (relating to automated red light enforcement  
14 systems in first class cities) and of any municipality that  
15 approved automated red light enforcement systems under this  
16 section. The evaluation shall include, but is not limited to,  
17 the effectiveness of automated red light enforcement systems in  
18 this Commonwealth and the conditions that should be present in  
19 order for a municipality to consider approving automated red  
20 light enforcement systems at intersections within the  
21 municipality based on the class and size of the municipality,  
22 the average daily traffic, the number of collisions and  
23 fatalities, the collection of fines, the revenue limit and the  
24 allocation of revenue received. The department shall complete  
25 the evaluation by June 1, 2017, and provide a copy to the  
26 chairperson of the Transportation Committee of the Senate and  
27 the chairperson of the Transportation Committee of the House of  
28 Representatives.

29 [(r)] (s) Expiration.--This section shall expire July 15,  
30 [2017] 2027.

31 [(s)] (t) Definitions.--As used in this section:

32 (1) The term "designee" shall include a person, business  
33 entity or governmental entity, including the department.

34 (2) The term "municipality" means:

35 (i) A city, borough or township with a population

1 under the 2010 Federal Decennial Census exceeding 20,000  
2 with a police agency accredited by the Pennsylvania  
3 Chiefs of Police Association in a county of the second  
4 class A.

5 (ii) A city, borough or township with a population  
6 under the 2010 Federal Decennial Census exceeding 20,000  
7 with a police agency accredited by the Pennsylvania  
8 Chiefs of Police Association in a county of the third  
9 class with a population between 490,000 and 510,000.

10 (iii) A city of the second class.
