- (b) Condition. -- As a condition of receiving and maintaining 22 grants or loans under this act, the recipients shall ensure that 23 24 all contractors and subcontractors engaged to perform 25 construction, reconstruction, demolition, alteration and repair work, other than maintenance work, on any segment of work on the 26 site of the facility or on a shared infrastructure project, pay 27 28 not less than the prevailing minimum wage and benefit rates for 29 all crafts and classifications, as determined by the Department 30 of Labor and Industry under the Prevailing Wage Act.
