## AN ACT

Amending Title 61 (Prisons and Parole) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, in miscellaneous provisions relating to inmate confinement, providing for feminine hygiene 3 products. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 7 Section 1. Title 61 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: 9 § 5908. Feminine hygiene products. 10 (a) Issuance. --11 (1) A supply of feminine hygiene products shall be provided to all female inmates in a State correctional 12 13 institution each month at no cost to the female inmates regardless of financial means. The department shall determine 14 15 the quantity of products and the frequency with which they 16 shall be provided to female inmates.

(2) Female inmates shall not be required to show proof

- of need to receive the products.
- 2 (3) Female inmates shall not be required to undergo a
- 3 medical examination or obtain a medical permit, authorization
- 4 <u>or diagnosis to receive the products.</u>
- 5 (b) Products provided. -- The following products shall be
- 6 <u>distributed to all female inmates in a State correctional</u>
- 7 institution:
- 8 (1) A choice of at least two sizes or absorbencies of
- 9 <u>sanitary pads, capable of absorbing at least five milliliters</u>
- of liquid each.
- 11 (2) A choice of at least two sizes of tampons, capable
- of absorbing at least four milliliters of liquid each.
- 13 (c) Rules and regulations. -- The department shall promulgate
- 14 rules and regulations necessary to implement and enforce the
- 15 provisions of this section.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
