AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in computer offenses, providing for 2 misuse of Commonwealth computer, computer network or cellular 3 phone. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 7642. Misuse of Commonwealth computer, computer network or 10 cellular phone. 11 (a) Offense defined. --12 (1) Except as authorized or required by official duties, 13 an employee of the Commonwealth commits a misdemeanor of the 14 third degree if the employee knowingly utilizes a 15 Commonwealth-owned computer, computer network or cellular 16 phone to display, disseminate, view, access, transfer, 17 transmit or retransmit a photograph, video or other visual depiction of explicit sexual materials. 18

- 1 (2) Nothing under this section may supersede a
- 2 prosecution for conduct prohibited under section 5903
- 3 <u>(relating to obscene and other sexual materials and</u>
- 4 <u>performances</u>) or 6312 (relating to sexual abuse of children).
- 5 (b) Defense. -- It shall be a defense under this section that
- 6 the employee received the prohibited depiction and viewed the
- 7 prohibited depiction without prior knowledge of the prohibited
- 8 <u>depiction's contents, did not retransmit the prohibited</u>
- 9 <u>depiction and immediately reported the receipt of the prohibited</u>
- 10 depiction to the employee's immediate supervisor.
- 11 (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 12 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 13 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 14 "Explicit sexual materials." An image of a person or portion
- 15 of the human body that depicts nudity or sexual conduct.
- 16 "Nudity." Showing of the human male or female genitals,
- 17 pubic area or buttocks with less than a fully opaque covering
- 18 or showing the female breast with less than a fully opaque
- 19 covering of any portion of the female breast below the top of
- 20 the nipple.
- "Sexual conduct." Sexual intercourse, anal or oral sodomy,
- 22 sexual bestiality, masturbation, excretory functions or
- 23 sadomasochistic abuse.
- 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
