Sale of tobacco. 9 10 Offense defined. -- Except as set forth in subsection (f), 11 a person is quilty of a summary offense if the person: sells a tobacco product to [any minor] an individual 12 13 under 21 years of age; furnishes, by purchase, gift or other means, a 14 15 tobacco product to [a minor] an individual under 21 years of 16 age; 17 locates or places a tobacco vending machine
