AN ACT

- Amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses) and 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in riot, disorderly conduct and related offenses, further providing for the offense of cruelty to animals; and, in child protective services, further providing for persons required to report suspected child abuse.

 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- 18 <u>cruelty to animals incorporated under the laws of this</u>
- 19 Commonwealth.
