## AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in riot, disorderly conduct and related offenses, providing for the offense of use of live
- 4 animals in traveling exhibitions.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 5511.4. Use of live animals in traveling exhibitions.
- 10 (a) Offense defined. -- No person who is an exhibitor may
- 11 employ or use any exotic animal or exotic wildlife in an animal
- 12 act, ride, performance or exhibition as part of a traveling show
- 13 or exhibition if, during the 15-day period preceding the
- 14 employment or use, the animal was living or traveling in a
- 15 mobile housing facility.
- 16 (b) Applicability. -- Subsection (a) shall not apply to the
- 17 <u>use of an animal, including a nonhuman primate:</u>
- 18 <u>(1) in an exhibition at a nonmobile, permanent</u>
- 19 institution or facility, including an accredited zoo or

- 1 <u>aquarium;</u>
- 2 (2) as part of an outreach program for educational or
- 3 conservation purposes by a zoo or aquarium accredited by the
- 4 Association of Zoos and Aquariums, if the animal is not kept
- 5 in a mobile housing facility for more than 12 hours per day;
- 6 (3) by a university, college, laboratory or other
- 7 <u>research facility registered with the United States Secretary</u>
- 8 <u>of Agriculture under section 6 of the Animal Welfare Act</u>
- 9 (Public Law 89-544, 7 U.S.C. § 2136); or
- 10 (4) in film, television or advertising, if the use does
- 11 <u>not involve a live public exhibition.</u>
- 12 <u>(c) Penalty.--A person who violates this section commits a</u>
- 13 <u>misdemeanor of the third degree.</u>
- 14 (d) Definitions. -- The following words and phrases when used
- 15 <u>in this section shall have the meanings given to them in this</u>
- 16 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 17 "Domestic animal." The term includes, but is not limited to,
- 18 a dog, cat, equine animal, bovine animal, rabbit, sheep, goat or
- 19 porcine animal. The term does not include an exotic animal or
- 20 exotic wildlife.
- 21 "Domestic fowl." An axis raised for food, hobby or sport.
- 22 "Exhibitor." A person who exhibits an animal to the public
- 23 <u>for compensation. The term includes, but is not limited to, the</u>
- 24 owner and operator of a carnival, circus, fair or zoo that
- 25 exhibits an animal, whether for profit or not. The term does not
- 26 include:
- 27 <u>(1) the owner or operator of a retail pet store;</u>
- (2) a person who owns a common, domesticated household
- 29 <u>pet and who derives less than a substantial portion of income</u>
- from a nonprimary source for exhibiting an animal that

- 1 <u>exclusively resides at the residence of the person; or</u>
- 2 (3) an organization that sponsors or a person who
- 3 participates with domestic animal or domestic fowl species in
- 4 <u>a purebred dog or cat show, or a state or county fair or</u>
- 5 livestock show intended to advance the agricultural arts and
- 6 <u>sciences</u>.
- 7 "Exotic animal." An animal that is native to a foreign
- 8 country or of foreign origin or character, is not native to the
- 9 <u>United States or was introduced from abroad and includes all</u>
- 10 hybrids of the animal. The term includes, but is not limited to,
- 11 <u>a nonhuman primate, lion, tiger, leopard, elephant, camel, </u>
- 12 antelope, anteater, kangaroo, water buffalo and any species of
- 13 foreign domestic cattle, such as ankole, gayal and yak.
- 14 "Exotic wildlife." As defined in 34 Pa.C.S. § 2961 (relating
- 15 to definitions).
- 16 "Mobile housing facility." A transporting vehicle,
- 17 including, but not limited to, a truck, trailer or railway car
- 18 used to house animals while traveling for exhibition or public
- 19 education purposes.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
