A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing April 19, 2024, as "Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia 2 Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, One in every 2,500 pregnancies are diagnosed with a
- 4 congenital diaphragmatic hernia (CDH); and
- 5 WHEREAS, CDH occurs when a baby's diaphragm fails to fully
- 6 form allowing abdominal organs into the chest cavity and
- 7 preventing lung growth; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Since 2000, it is estimated that over 700,000 babies
- 9 have been born with CDH, however only 50% of those babies
- 10 survived; and
- 11 WHEREAS, CDH is as common as spina bifida and cystic
- 12 fibrosis, however very few people know or are aware of it; and
- 13 WHEREAS, There are about 1,600 babies born with CDH each year
- 14 in the United States; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Many people in this Commonwealth have been diagnosed
- 16 with and survived CDH, although many families have endured the
- 17 horrible pain and grief associated with the loss of loved ones
- 18 with CDH; and

- 1 WHEREAS, CDH International is a 501(c)(3) charity
- 2 organization that was created to help families affected by CDH;
- 3 and
- 4 WHEREAS, Those with CDH often endure multiple surgeries and
- 5 possible medical complications beyond their diagnosis, including
- 6 heart defects, pulmonary complications, gastric and intestinal
- 7 problems and developmental delays, and may require respiratory
- 8 and medicinal support for years; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Raising awareness of this congenital defect will
- 10 help bring about acceptance and support for those suffering with
- 11 CDH and will help advocate for urgently needed medical research
- 12 and advances; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize April 19, 2024, as
- 14 "Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania.
