- 4 § 5211. Definitions.
- 5 The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
- 6 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 7 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 8 "Municipal corporation." A city, county, borough, township,
- 9 <u>incorporated town, home rule municipality, optional plan</u>
- 10 municipality or optional charter municipality.
- 11 "Public notice." Notice published once each week for two
- 12 <u>successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation and on</u>
- 13 the municipal corporation's website, if the municipal
- 14 corporation has a publicly accessible Internet website.
- 15 § 5212. Sale or lease of water or sewer system.
- In addition to the provisions of 65 Pa.C.S. Ch. 7 (relating
- 17 to open meetings), prior to entering into an agreement to sell
- 18 or lease a water or sewer system owned or operated by a
- 19 municipal corporation or to sell or lease a water or sewer
- 20 system currently owned or operated by a municipal authority that
- 21 would require dissolution by the municipal corporation, the
- 22 municipal corporation shall hold at least one advertised public
- 23 meeting, not more than 60 days nor fewer than seven days prior
- 24 to entering into the agreement with the potential purchaser or
- 25 <u>lessee</u>, and shall provide public notice of the meeting in all
- 26 municipalities served by the water or sewer system. The
- 27 potential purchaser or lessee shall attend the meeting.
- 28 § 5213. Requisite consent for acquisition of water or
- 29 <u>wastewater companies.</u>
- 30 An acquisition of an entity subject to section 5610(a.1)

- 1 (relating to governing body) under 66 Pa.C.S. § 1329 (relating
- 2 to valuation of acquired water and wastewater systems) may not
- 3 <u>be deemed in the public interest by the Pennsylvania Public</u>
- 4 <u>Utility Commission without the unanimous consent of the</u>
- 5 governing body established under section 5610(a.1).
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
