AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in certification of teachers, repealing certificates issued by other states and providing 5 for out-of-state applicants for certifications. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 1206 of the act of March 10, 1949 11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 12 repealed: 13 [Section 1206. Certificates Issued by Other States. -- (a) Candidates holding a valid instructional certificate issued by 14 15 another state may be eligible for comparable Pennsylvania 16 certification provided that the candidate meets the following 17 requirements: 18 Holds a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or 19 university.

(2) Has at least two (2) years of successful classroom

- 1 experience.
- 2 (3) Demonstrates subject matter competency in the applicable
- 3 area of Pennsylvania certification.
- 4 (4) Satisfies the requirements of section 1209.
- 5 (b) The Secretary of Education shall adopt standards and
- 6 guidelines as necessary to implement this section.
- 7 (c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit
- 8 the Secretary of Education from certifying out-of-State
- 9 applicants in accordance with regulations of the Department of
- 10 Education or the State Board of Education.]
- 11 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 12 Section 1206.1. Out-of-State Applicants for Certification.--
- 13 (a) Candidates from other states seeking Pennsylvania
- 14 <u>certification must satisfy one of the following:</u>
- 15 (1) The candidate must hold a valid and current_
- 16 <u>instructional certificate issued by another state and satisfy</u>
- 17 the following:
- (i) Completion of a college or university educator
- 19 preparation program approved by the certifying state,
- 20 <u>satisfaction of testing requirements demonstrating subject</u>
- 21 matter competency in the applicable area of Pennsylvania
- 22 <u>certification</u>, including passage of equivalent content tests
- 23 required by the certifying state and field experience.
- 24 (ii) For a candidate who has taught on the out-of-state
- 25 certificate, presentation to the department evidence of
- 26 <u>satisfactory professional educator experience for the</u>
- 27 candidate's two most recent years of classroom teaching.
- 28 (2) The candidate must hold a valid certificate issued by
- 29 the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards. A
- 30 candidate with a certificate shall be granted the highest-level

- 1 Pennsylvania certification available in the candidate's area of
- 2 certification.
- 3 (b) An out-of-state candidate who satisfies the requirements
- 4 of subsection (a) must also satisfy this Commonwealth's
- 5 requirements under sections 1202 and 1209.
- 6 (c) An out-of-state candidate who is seeking Pennsylvania
- 7 <u>certification in a subject identified by the department as a</u>
- 8 shortage area and meets the requirements of subsections (a) and
- 9 (b) shall be issued the appropriate certificate on an expedited
- 10 basis in accordance with this section.
- 11 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
